## NOTICE TO RESIDENT

RE: Amick Avenue Curb Replacement

The City of Des Moines will have a contractor working on replacing the curbs along Amick Avenue from Beaver Avenue to 38<sup>th</sup> Street. The contractor should start work at the end of May or first part of June.

The contractor will be replacing short sections of curb at a time to minimize the amount of construction disruption adjacent to the brick roadway. This work will take a few weeks to complete. While the contractor is working, there will be short lane closures in the immediate areas of construction. As short sections are complete, the contractor will continue down the road until all the curb replacement is completed. Take note of where the contractor is located and try to avoid the work area. After the curbs are placed, they will be backfilled and seeded.

During construction, mail and solid waste collection services will be continued. The new curbs will be placed between existing driveways. Driveways will not be reconstructed and will remain open during construction.
