

Please join the Beaverdale Neighborhood Association, the Des Moines Police and Fire Departments, Westminster Presbyterian Church, and multiple Beaverdale businesses to celebrate National Night Out on Tuesday, August 2, 2022 from 6:30-8:30pm. This is an evening of free (or highly discounted) family fun, designed to help neighbors interact with first responders and with other neighbors. Beaverdale's National Night Out event will be held at the intersection of Beaver and Franklin Avenues.

FAREWAY MEAT MARKET OPENS ANOTHER REASON TO LOVE BEAVERDALE!

After much planning and construction work, Fareway opened its Meat Market at the corner of Beaver and Urbandale Avenues on Wednesday, June 15th. The 7,800 foot store offers a wide selection of meats, prepared foods and a number of other groceries. There's a long meat counter with beef, pork, chicken and fish - plus ready-to-cook items for the grill like jalapeno burgers, skewers and stuffed mushrooms.

It took a year to build the store, following city council approval of plans. It features a mostly brick exterior, with a large steer in a second floor window looking out over the corner of Beaver and Urbandale. Some nearby neighbors expressed concerns during the planning process about the need to tear down a house on the west edge of the property and about increased traffic on 41st Street Place. Des Moines Mayor Frank Cownie said at the grand opening, "This is a wonderful example of how the planning process should work where ideas are vetted, conversations held, and consensus built to deliver something that is beneficial to the community and our residents."

Fareway CEO Reynolds Cramer said, "We want to thank the area community and key stakeholders for their support in making the project possible, and welcoming Fareway to this great neighborhood." Early indications are that traffic has been brisk at the store. The Fareway Meat Market is open Monday-Saturday 8am-8pm.
