PROCESS OVERVIEW

- 1. Form a team of at least five (5) neighbors
- 2. Host information session with City of Des Moines
- 3. Team leader contacts City Staff to receive a Team OneDrive
- 4. Team completes application and submits materials to OneDrive
- 5. City Staff reviews projects and follows up as needed
- 6. City Staff sends application approvals/rejections
- 7. Homeowners complete their projects and submit reimbursement requests
