To Whom It May Concern:

As part of the City of Des Moines' 2020-2021 asphalt overlay program, the Public Works Department has scheduled the asphalt overlay of 38th Street from Urbandale Ave to Adams Ave. The preparatory work, including milling, patching and cleanup will begin on Monday, April 19, 2021 at approximately 8:00 AM. During this time, the street will be open to local traffic only. However, please use caution when traveling near the construction area – your safe driving protects our employees and your family.

On Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at approximately 8:00 AM, the asphalt overlay will be placed, weather permitting. During construction of the overlay (8:00 AM to 5:00 PM), the street will be closed to all traffic. This may affect access to your property, and arrangements should be made for alternate access during the construction. The street should be reopened to all traffic by 5 PM. In case of inclement weather, the work will be rescheduled for Thursday, April 22, 2021 at approximately 8:00 AM.

If the asphalt overlay is scheduled on the day of your solid waste collection, the collection will be completed prior to the start of the construction on that day.
